Each group of two students, will be provided with a 4'x4' Masonite board, (primed in white). If you would like to participate, but do not have a partner, a 2'x2' Masonite board, (primed in white) will be provided.

ALL other materials: Paint, mixed- media supplies, paint brushes, any adhesives needed, 2D or 3D materials (appropriate for public display), and cleaning supplies, is to be provided by the students. Note: Please be sure to bring Sun protective clothing, Sunscreen, and shade materials such as sun umbrella.

\*Water will be available, please bring a container/jar, or bucket. The works of art can be mixed media, or just painted.

## Prizes will be awarded for:

First Place: \$100 (per person) Second Place: \$75 (per person) Third Place: \$50 (per person) Fourth Place: \$25 (per person)
